- (iii) It is an offence to include incorrect information in the application.
- (iv) Applicants currently working under Governing Council/Board of Governors are encouraged to apply.
- (v) Only shortlisted and successful applicants will be contacted.
- (vi) Canvassing in any form will lead to automatic disqualification.
- (vii) The Public Service Commission is committed to implementing the provisions of the Constitution - Chapter 232 (1) on fair competition and merit, representation of Kenya's diverse communities and affording equal employment opportunities to men and women, members of all ethnic groups and persons with disabilities. **THEREFORE, PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES, THE MARGINALIZED AND THE MINORITIES ARE ENCOURAGED TO APPLY.**
